STRENGTH IN NUMBERS

Indian tribes and Municipalities as Natural Allies

"The entire American real property system is built on land stolen from Native peoples and would collapse if that land was returned to Native peoples. Empowering municipalities to reject harmful corporate projects would upend the legal mandate to maximize shareholder wealth. Judges and politicians are fully aware of this. And, they're not going to be persuaded to change the dominant power arrangement.
